2019 is a pivotal year for Africa - Diaspora Relations - the government of Ghana declares 2019 Year of Return for the diaspora to visit Ghana.

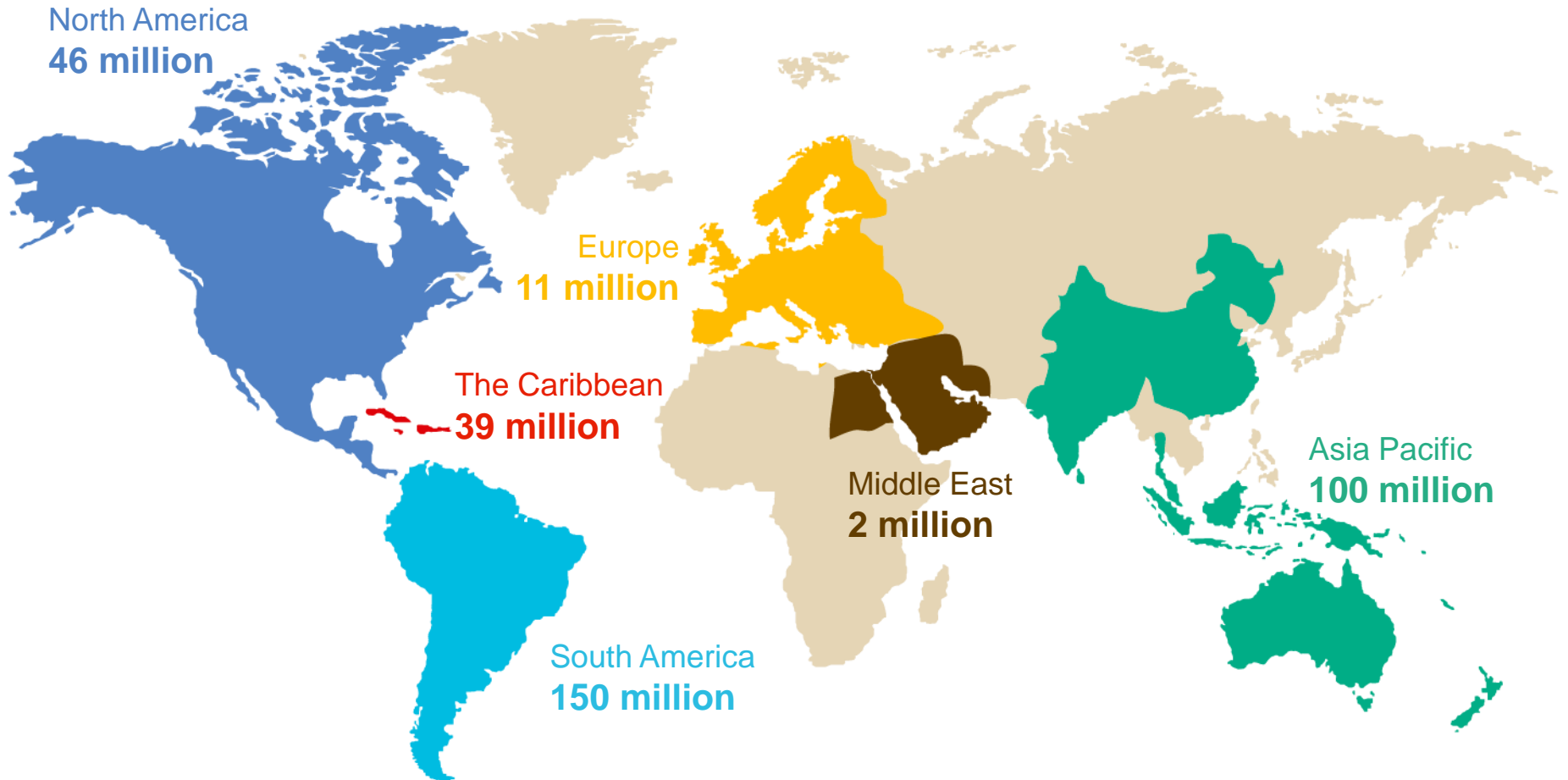
